



Shocker Concept Helmet – Template

Patterns shown are set up to fit on 8.5x11 sheets of paper.

Pieces are for LEFT side of head and need to be flipped and mirrored for other side.

Recommended for 5 mm craft foam unless otherwise noted Connect matching numbers in no particular order

Current patterns will fit head size 22"

Increase Tile Scale to 105% for larger heads

Decrease Tile Scale to 95% for smaller heads

Directions

- Cut and transfer patterns onto 5mm craft foam
- Cut foam according to notes listed on patterns
- Use heat gun for better forming before gluing
- Glue pieces together by matching numbers and letters from pattern. No Particular Order.
- Use elastic straps to secure back band to helmet.
- Once assembled and finished, take a photo and send us a photo of how it turns out.

CUTTING TECHNIQUES



V UNDER CUT

cut a v shape on the under side where noted.
glue inner walls together.



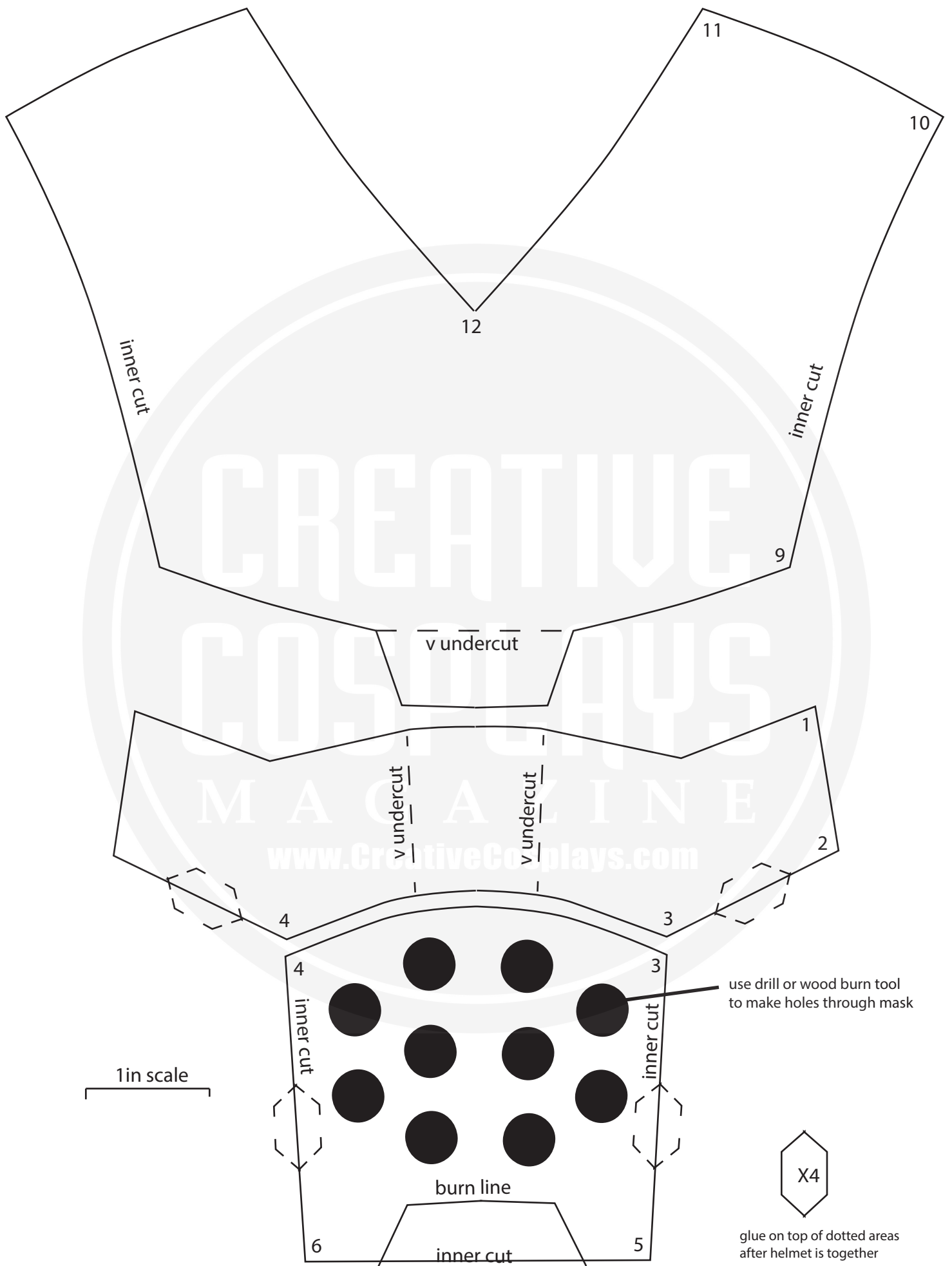
INNER CUT

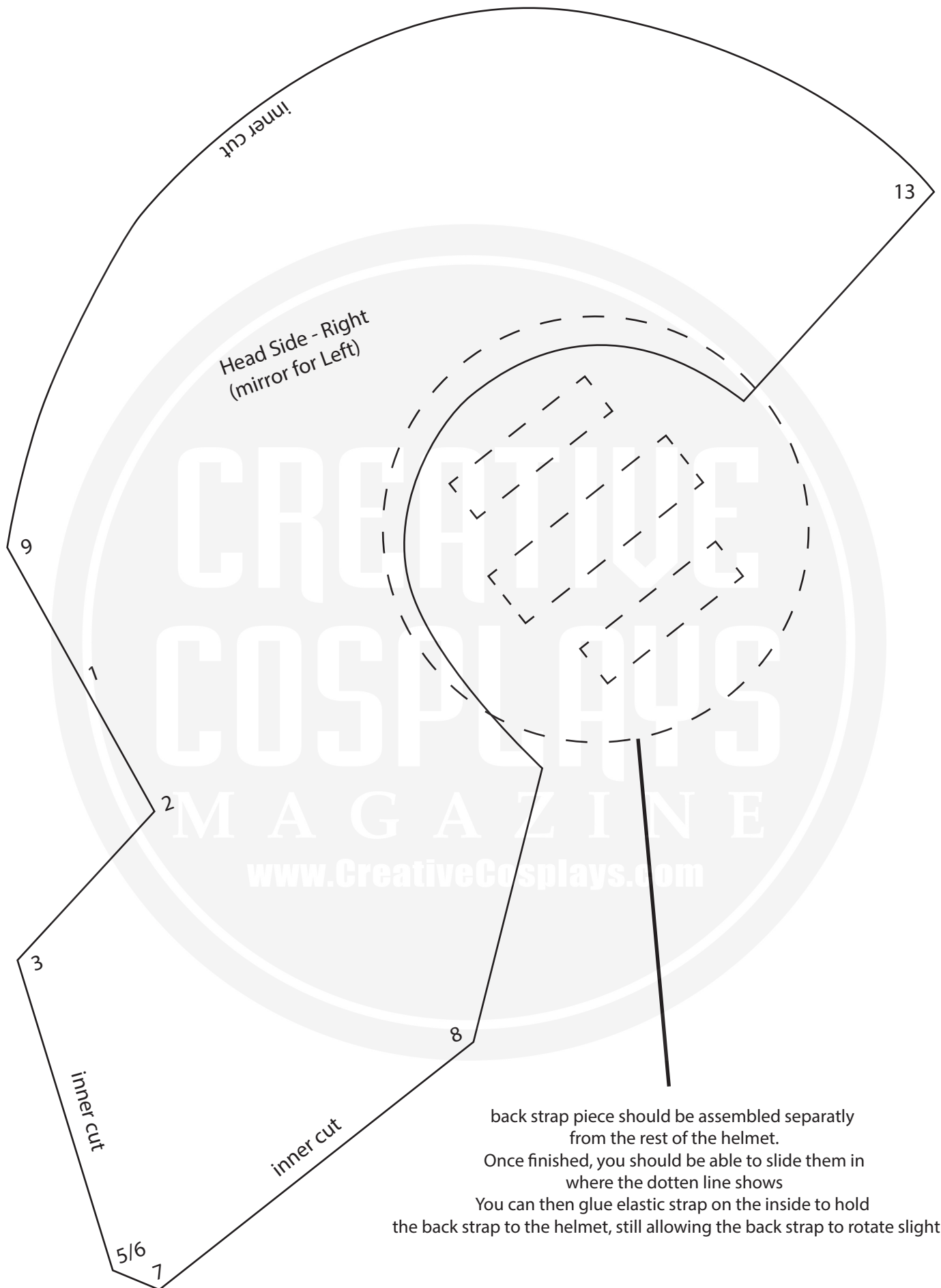
cut along line inwards at a 45 deg angle



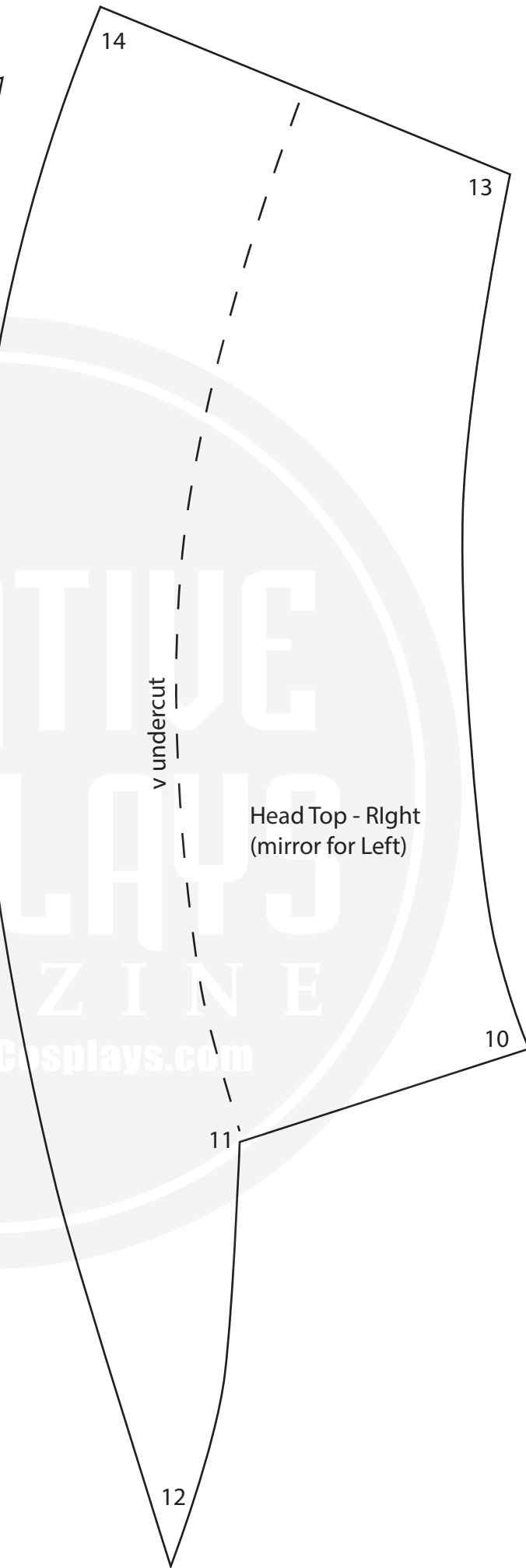
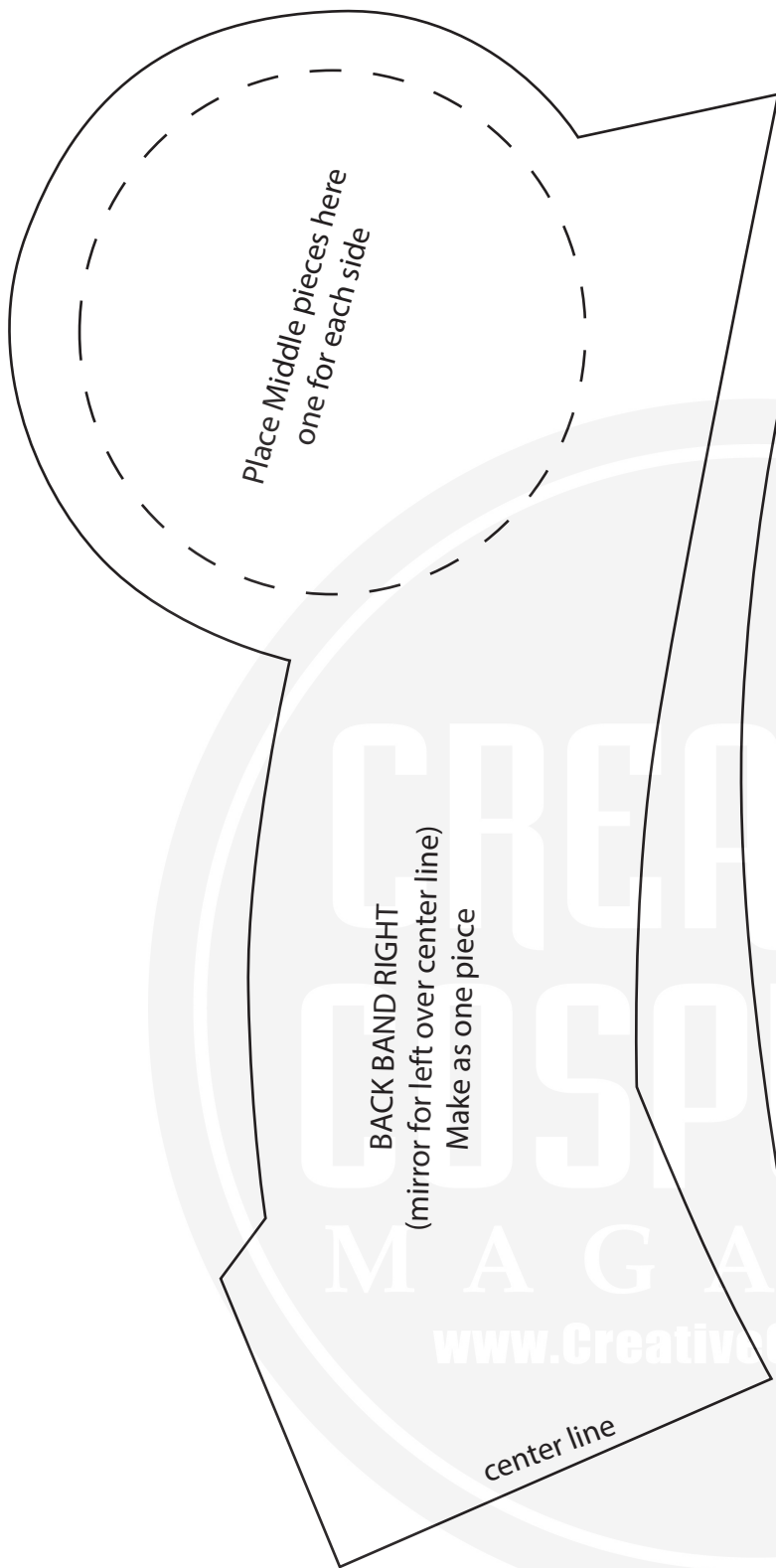
OUTER CUT

cut along line outwards at a 45 deg angle





back strap piece should be assembled separately from the rest of the helmet.
Once finished, you should be able to slide them in where the dotted line shows
You can then glue elastic strap on the inside to hold the back strap to the helmet, still allowing the back strap to rotate slightly.
